A Campaign for Transformational Expansion of Arts Education in Hampton Roads

The Governor's School is a center for innovation that develops excellence, nurtures creativity, inspires artistic vision and builds communities with a passion for the arts.

Specifically, the campaign will fund:

- 1) Increase in the student body and faculty
- 2) Expansion of GSA's facility on Granby Street

Each January, more than 500 students in Hampton Roads summon their courage and participate in their own personal version of "Fame" - auditioning to be accepted to attend The Governor's School for the Arts, a program that offers premier arts training to high school students in six departments of study: Dance, Instrumental Music, Musical Theatre, Theatre & Film, Visual Arts and Vocal Music.

Every year, The Governor's School for the Arts, which attracts students from the eight cities and counties of South Hampton Roads, turns away hundreds of qualified students.

Now, The Governor's School has expanded its instructional space, and with it can significantly increase enrollment and transform its impact on students, and the entire community, for decades to come.

The Governor's School for the Arts GSA stands as an outstanding example of regional cooperation serving the cities of Chesapeake, Franklin, Norfolk, Portsmouth, Suffolk and Virginia Beach, along with Isle of Wight and Southampton counties. Students attend their home school for academics, and then travel to the GSA campus on Granby Street in Norfolk for additional education in their chosen art form.

99% of Governor's School students go on to pursue higher education. On average, each year's approximately 100 graduating students earn more than \$15 million in scholarships - to some of the most prestigious schools and universities in the country.

The result of this expansion will take The Governor's School for the Arts' renowned arts education program to an even higher level, affording the students an experience that transcends the classroom and traditional performance venues by reaching out into the community to create an unprecedented creative energy in education.

This newest expansion of its facilities gives us our own orchestra rehearsal hall which doubles as a recital hall, new dance studios, a new jazz room, locker rooms, classrooms, and an art gallery. And this expansion gives us room in the main building to add a film studio and more practice and studio rooms. For the first time in the history of the school the entire student body is under one roof. This has had a positive impact on the safety of our students and has made collaboration of students, staff, and resources much easier. Our students are reaping the benefits!
