Overview

The Governor’s School for the Arts does not have onsite parking. While each participating school division provides transportation for students enrolled at GSA, some students do elect to drive a personal vehicle. Any students providing their own transportation are responsible for the costs associated with parking and do so at their own risk.

Daily Parking

Students who do not drive to GSA on a regular basis, yet choose to drive on occasion, should park at MacArthur Center. The South Deck has entrances off of City Hall Avenue and Cumberland Street, while the North Deck has entrances off of Market Street. Rates are as follows:

Monthly Parking

Any student planning to drive to GSA on a regular basis should secure a parking pass for the Freemason Garage from the City of Norfolk. This can be done in person at the Main Street Parking Building, which is located at 230 W. Main Street, Norfolk, Virginia 23510. They can be contacted at 757-664-6222 and are open from 8:30am to 4:30pm, Monday through Friday. Students should see Alexton Craft in the GSA Office to obtain a letter certifying enrollment at GSA for the current year, as this is required by the City of Norfolk.
